

Holidays in Corsica? Campsite is better, for 5 reasons

Corsica is easy to access from Italian coastline and astonishing for her beauty and landscape variety: the isle offers the best of itself to tourists who choose to stay in the many campsites and villages on the island. Is it just a matter of cost containment? Absolutely not! If pearlescent beaches and a crystal clear sea are just a glossy cover for Corsica, that help her in seducing more and more tourists each year, the authentic "Ile de beauté" (Isle of beauty in English) is a book, which must be slowly leafed through. This is the only way to surrender to her picturesque landscapes and to discover her rich history, made unique by all the traditions and happenings. Corsica is the ideal destination for excursion lovers and for anyone travelling by motorbike or car (less ideal for those travelling by camper, due to the narrow roads) because the campsites are the perfect "base camps" from where to start the isle visit.

- 1. A natural choice: even if many Italian and European tourists choose Corsica for her crystal clear waters, the isle boasts some of the higher mountains in the Mediterranean Sea. One for all is the Monte Cinto (monte Cintu, in Corsican), with its 2.706 mt height. A picturesque scenery is offered by the geological formation of the Calanche di Piana, red granite rising straight from the sea. Reliefs and streams, together with a typical Mediterranean climate, offer the perfect ambient for more than 2.000 plants and a rich fauna.
- 2. **A sea of surprises:** beaches served with every comfort, even crowded during the high season, alternate with small coves that ensure privacy and relaxation. The combination of the pearly beaches with crystal clear waters creates the suggestion of being on a Caribbean beach.
- 3. **The ideal climate at any time**: thanks to the Mediterranean climate and the constant breeze, Corsica has a pleasant temperature at any time of the day and of the night. Thanks to the many reliefs, woods and paths there are many opportunities to escape from summer heat or to interchange sea days to pleasant excursions. Precisely this landscape variety makes of Corsica an ideal destination, not only during summer but in any season of the year.
- 4. **Tradition and innovation:** Corsica has the astonishing skill to merge local traditions, especially in the small villages, to a quite new vocation for mass tourism. The discovery of the island far from the high season, from the more known tourist routes or even on the road by motorbike or car, is the best way to truly experience the essence of this land and the welcome of a people proud of his territory.

Campsites and holiday villages for any travel style: among the campsites and tourist resorts present on Campeggi.com, we recommend the Camping Arinella Bianca in Ghisonaccia (Haute-Corse), with its 5 stars perfect also for more demanding tourists. Moreover, we would like to signal the Camping Caravaning Isulottu in Centuri (Haute-Corse) on the northern point of Corsica and the Camping La Pomposa in Bonifacio (Corse-du-Sud) at the southern point. And for the most demanding requirements, the Naturiste Riva Bella Thalasso & Spa Resort in Aleria (Haute-Corse) with its 4 stars naturist campsite.
